

Elementary Continued...

Session 7 (7/19) Cooking with NONI

 Campers will learn the basics of cooking and gain confidence around the kitchen as they plan, prepare, and taste a variety of individual portioned meals in a class led by Ms. Voni "Noni". Cooking and baking techniques, vocabulary and proper use of kitchen utensils will be explored. This camp will include a trip to a local Farmer's Market.

Session 8 (7/26) STEM / Jr. Engineers

Campers will learn the basics of engineering and architecture by using different materials to plan and build steady structures. Bay's STEM teacher, Ms. Allison, will lead campers through fun and safe engineering activities. Parents are invited to come share about their experience in the engineering field!

Session 9 (8/2) Woodworking

 A variety of basic woodworking tools will be presented to the campers with lessons on safe and proper handling. Campers will be able to create several small wooden projects during this week. This camp will include a day visit and swim at Jefferson-Patterson Park.

Session 10 (8/9) Drama

Campers will go on a creative journey as they express and discover themselves using a variety of visual and performing art forms. A local drama teacher, Ms. Megan, will lead campers through self-inspired adventures and activities.

Session 11 (8/16) Community Workers

Campers will learn about the importance of community and explore the jobs and skills needed to sustain a successful community. This camp will include several special visitors from our local



community workers. Parents are also invited to come share about the importance of their jobs!

Montessori Themed Camp for ages 3 & 4

Sessions 1-4 (6/7-7/2) Swim Lessons

Bay is fortunate to have a swimming pool on campus, staffed with a certified lifeguard! Campers will receive swim lessons, gain confidence in the pool and learn skills they can use throughout the summer. When the children aren't swimming, they will explore our campus and participate in organized activities.



Session 5 (7/6) Songs & Rhythm

Campers will gain an appreciation for music as they explore fun songs with coordinated movement and play a variety of instruments. They will learn about the importance of rhythm as they participate in a drum circle led by Ms. Sheila from *SoMarDrummers!*

Session 6 (7/12) Arts & Crafts

Let's get messy and colorful! Campers will have a chance to work with a variety of art materials to create crafts as they develop those fine motor skills. They will cut, glue, sculpt and learn about color mixing using different tools and paint on a variety of mediums. This camp will include a special craft with a local art teacher from *Just Paint Now*, Ms. Jamie.

Session 7 (7/19) STEM

Campers will gain an understanding of scientific and physical laws through experimentation and exploration! Bay's STEM teacher, Ms. Allison, will lead campers as they learn the basics of building strong structures and explore various physical science experiments in the classroom as well as outdoors.

Session 8 (7/26) Yoga & Movement

Yoga postures promote coordination, flexibility, focus and balance! Campers will be led through coordinated movement, stretching, yoga poses, breathing exercises and self-calming techniques in a class led by Ms. Kathy from *Evolve Yoga*.



Session 9 (8/2) The Joy of Cooking



Sessions 10&11 (8/9-20)

Montessori Camp

Campers will work with the Montessori materials in a Primary (3-5 year old) classroom. A trained Montessori teacher, Ms. Glenn, will present lessons and guide campers as they explore all areas of the Montessori environment.



Montessori Themed Camp for Two Year Olds

The Two Year Old program will be Montessori year-round. Students can attend one or all weeks during summer. Current students are given priority. Swim lessons are optional for an additional fee and begin week 5.



Montessori Themed Camp for school ages

Session 1 (6/7) The LEGO Challenge / swim lessons

Playing with LEGOs promotes math, engineering, and creativity! Campers will explore various building challenges using a variety of LEGOs. They will read and follow diagrams to build LEGO creations as well as learn to plan and construct their own creations.



Session 2 (6/14) Fitness & Fun / swim lessons

Campers will explore their bodies' potential as they participate in games and exercises that promote fitness and health! A teacher from *Evolve Yoga*, Ms. Kathy, will lead campers through a variety of yoga poses, breathing exercises and self-calming techniques. This camp will include a full day hike and swim at Calvert Cliffs.



Session 3 (6/21) Critters & Creatures / swim lessons

Campers will have a chance to get close and personal with a variety of critters and creatures in our environment! This camp will include two special visitors from *My Reptile Guys* as well as *Raptor's Eye*!

Session 4 (6/28) Space Camp / swim lessons

Let's get ready to explore beyond this world! Campers will have a chance to discover interesting facts about outer space as they learn to navigate a variety of virtual platforms about space. Friends will choose a specific subject to explore and present their findings at the end of the week. This camp will include an overnight campout in the meadow.



Session 5 (7/6) Movin' to the Music

Campers will make music through interactive activities in a fun and creative environment. They will participate in dance and movement games while experimenting with a variety of musical instruments. Ms. Sheila, from *SoMarDrummers*, will lead campers in a drum circle as they explore the importance of rhythm.

Session 6 (7/12) Painting Like a Master

There are no limits to creativity! Campers will learn painting and drawing techniques as they explore a variety of tools and mediums in an art class led by Ms. Jamie from *Just Paint Now*. They will use those skills to complete a weeklong art project of their choice.
