

# Montessori School Age Themed Camps

## WEEK #1

6/10

### Music Theory and Rythm

Campers will make music through interactive activities in a fun and creative environment led by our music teacher, Ms. Emma. They will participate in games and activities that teach theory while experimenting with a variety of musical instruments. Ms. Sheila, from SoMarDrummers, will lead campers in a drum circle as they explore the importance of rhythm.

## WEEK #2

6/17

### Art Lab \*

Imagine and create! Campers will work with a variety of art materials and learn new skills as they create beautiful crafts in a DIY lab led by Ms. Cathy. Papier-mâché, beads and jewels, paints and pencils, clay and much more will be available for kids to explore!

## WEEK #3

6/24

### Drama, Unscripted



In this fast-paced camp, campers will play a variety of games to help them practice thinking on their feet. They will work with props, collaboratively tell stories, practice expressing emotions through movement, and more! The week will culminate with an evening of improvisational performance on Friday after camp.

## WEEK #4

7/1

### STEM / Jr. Engineers \*\*

Campers will learn the basics of engineering and architecture by using different materials to plan and build steady structures. Teachers will lead campers through fun and safe engineering activities and experiments. Parents are invited to come share about their experience in the engineering field!

## WEEK #5

7/8

### Bread, Butter, and Jam

Starting with the basics, this camp will cover how to make bread, hand-churned butter, and fresh local jam. Campers will learn what goes into making these pantry staples that they likely eat every day. They will get a hands-on experience in a practical way as they plan, measure, gather, cook, taste, and prepare each component to enjoy together in a celebratory picnic on the last day.

## WEEK #6 7/15

### All About Dinosaurs

“Terrible lizard” is what paleontologists (dinosaur detectives) call the beasts from the Triassic, Jurassic, and Cretaceous Periods. Come experience digging up bones, excavating eggs and identifying tracks as we explore the world of dinosaurs! This camp will include a visit from My Reptile Guys.

### Storytime Fun for Everyone

Campers will enjoy hearing new stories and exploring the ins and outs of telling stories in a class led by our librarian, Ms. Susan. They will learn about the parts that make up a story and work on creating characters, settings, and stories of their own. The Mobile Library will visit Bay this week!

Campers will learn about the importance of community and explore the jobs and skills needed to sustain a successful community. This camp will include several special hero visitors from our local community workers. Parents are also invited to come share about the importance of their jobs!
